Subject: Devotions; LTNB Conference update

Greetings, all, in the **Glorious Golden** Name of **JESUS!**

Devotions this morning, by Sherri Riley, Customer Services were from I Thess 5:14-23; in particular we were blessed by verse 18.

1Th:5:14: Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, comfort the feebleminded, support the weak, be patient toward all men.

1Th:5:15: See that none render evil for evil unto any man; but ever follow that which is good, both among yourselves, and to all men.

1Th:5:16: Rejoice evermore.

1Th:5:17: Pray without ceasing.

1Th:5:18: In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.

1Th:5:19: Quench not the Spirit.

1Th:5:20: Despise not prophesyings.

1Th:5:21: Prove all things; hold fast that which is good.

1Th:5:22: Abstain from all appearance of evil.

1Th:5:23: And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Quick update on the **Light The Nation** Barbados Conference being held at Sherbourne:

Yesterday (Thursday 18 May 2000) several pastors met in the morning to pray. A friend told me that she tried to enter the hall and was met by a wave of God's presence and glory...that people were stretched on the floor weeping and interceding for our land.

Last night, at the general meeting, an intercessor shared of a vision the Lord had given her. Jesus was standing over the island with a sword in His hand. The word of the Lord was that He wishes to use this nation to touch the West Indies and the region. He is cutting a veil...the sword in His hand cut a veil over this land as though it was tissue...to thereby allow power to flow to and from us to heaven. The Lord will also use the sword to protect us from the enemy. There was a warning with the vision...that the enemy will try to put the veil back in place again, and that we need to have set up intercessors praying 24 hours a day over our land.

This vision seemed, to me, to correspond with my dream Monday night. I was hesitating to share its details before, but I will now give the details of it.

The enemy was coming against the land with troops on the ground and helicopters in the air. Christians were in retreat. Then, when we seemed cornered by the enemy, a sea of

cleansing (literally waves from the sea) rose and overflowed the land. The believers were as in a tall tower which shifted to and fro over the land as though on wheels, and led the waves which followed it to thereby drown the enemy's forces. There was great rejoicing.

I wish the dream had ended there, but it did not.

I saw next the evil prince who was in charge of the forces of the enemy over this land. He was not the devil but one of his princes. The victory over his forces was pointed out to him, and it was indicated that he should leave the land. I thought he would, but he did not. Instead he declared he would be launching a new attack. A pleasure tent was then set up by him in the middle of the land and wickedness took place in it. People were drawn into the tent, and their minds were lured away thus from God.

There the dream ended with a "to be continued" feeling, much to my annoyance because I had wanted it to end with a total victory over the enemy and his banishment from the land. I awoke feeling sick in my spirit, and feeling the dire need to pray...that we need to pray...that the enemy is not going to leave the land without us praying and without a battle, despite the initial victory.

I urge us all, one final time, to attend the final Sherbourne Conference session tonight at 7pm, and/or the meeting at Combermere School Hall tomorrow night at 7pm, and to catch the vision of taking this nation for God. Apart from the anointed speakers, there are many great books, tapes, etc. on sale. (Admission itself is free). Last night Pastor Victor Lorenzo shared the historical background about the revival in Argentina, which is now about 50% Christian. What struck me is that the major initial hindrance to revival had been the disunity among God's people. The Pastor shared an interesting equation: % unity = % blessing.

I will give a fuller report later on the conference. For now, it's over and out.
